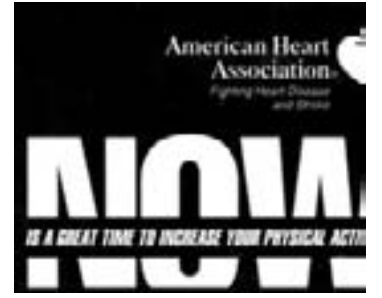
- 10 a.m. - Sewing Non-wearable - all divisions
