DCMS cross country teams both finish first

The end of August was a busy time for the Delphi Middle School co-ed cross-country team. On Aug. 28 the boys and girls teams traveled to Monon and competed against North White. Both teams finished first. Top finishers for the girls' team were Ariel Isley (1st), Emily Layman (2nd), Annie Mose (5th), Taylor Hudelson (6th), and Morgan Edwards (7th).
