On or about March 19, 2010, the Town of Camden intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs' Community Focus Fund of the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This program is funded by Title I of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: Downtown Revitalization Project which will include curbing, gutter, sidewalks, street lights and other amenities. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$500,000. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low- and moderate-income persons is \$261,250. The Applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$60,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: General Fund (\$35,000) Economic Development (\$15,000), Motor Vehicle Highway (\$5,000) and Local Roads and Streets (\$5,000).

The Town of Camden will hold a public hearing on March 11, 2010, at 7:00p.m., in Camden-Jackson Twp Public Library Reading Room to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG project. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.
